

Hi Everyone!

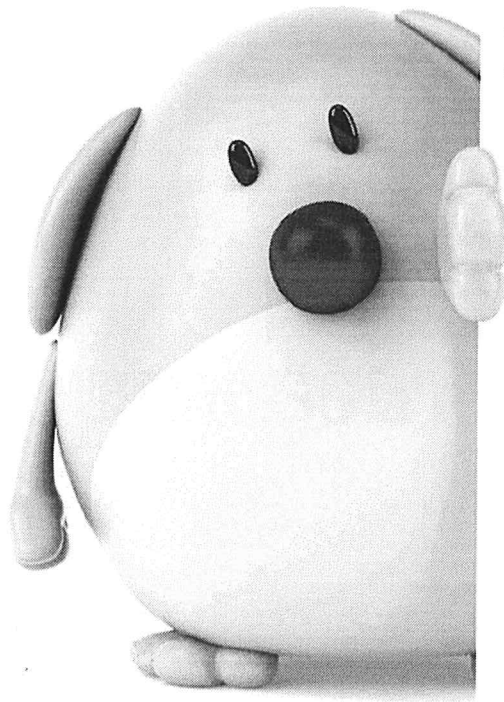
I hope you are all well.

LITERACY:

Practice reading all sight words (2 pages) out aloud.	
Read the story "Don's Bet" out aloud:	
With a coloured pencil, colour all CAPITAL letters.	
With a different coloured pencil, circle all punctuation (" or ! or . or ?).	
Writing: On sheet provided, write a short paragraph about the story you have just read. Draw a picture to match. Use your writing checklist to check your work.	
Read all of the sight words at the bottom of the story paying attention to the different letter combinations: leal as in 'seat', leel as in 'feet'.	
Handwriting: Trace capital and lowercase letters neatly then write again next to each letter on sheet.	

- If you do not have a paper copy of this,
 - write a list of the words from the story that start with a capital letter.
 - neatly rewrite all letters of the alphabet in capital and lowercase letters.

NUMERACY:

Count forwards to 100 (you can use the hundreds chart if you need)	
Count backwards from 50	
Count by 10's to 100	
Count backwards from 100 by 10's	
Count by 5's to 100	
Count by 2's to 20 or as far as you can go	
Write in missing numbers on hundreds chart (see worksheet)	
Complete 'Addition' and 'Subtraction' questions on worksheet.
