

The Last Supper

The Last Supper was a special meal shared by Jesus and his friends during Passover.

Jesus and the disciples were eating quietly because they were worried. It was a very dangerous time for Jesus. Many people wanted to kill him because they were angry that he was so popular.



When Jesus spoke, he said, "I tell you the truth, one of you here will betray me." All of his disciples seemed shocked. They wondered which of them it would be.

He then changed back into his normal clothes and returned to the table.
