# Coral Reefs

Coral reefs are home to some of the most amazing sea creatures. These animals have unique adaptations to protect themselves from predators. For example, the Spotfin Lionfish has venomous spines that extend out from its body, harming other species in the reef that get too close to them.

Another incredible creature is the Pygmy Seahorse. The Pygmy Seahorse grows no bigger than 2cm (0.79in), and camouflages to closely match the coral it lives on. Mandarinfish also live in the reefs. These animals are truly unique; they do not have fish scales, but instead are covered in a mucus coating. The coating gives them a bright blue and orange coloring, as well as making them smell and taste unpleasant to predators.

Coral reefs are home to many other amazing underwater creatures.

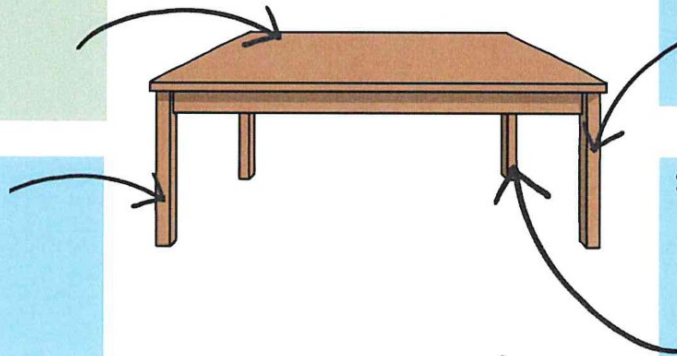

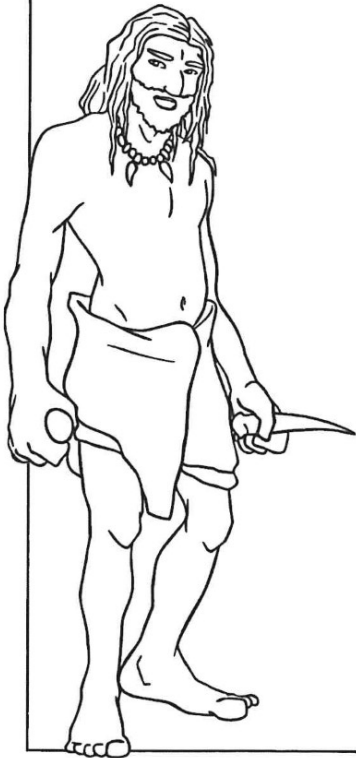
# Cavemen Column Addition

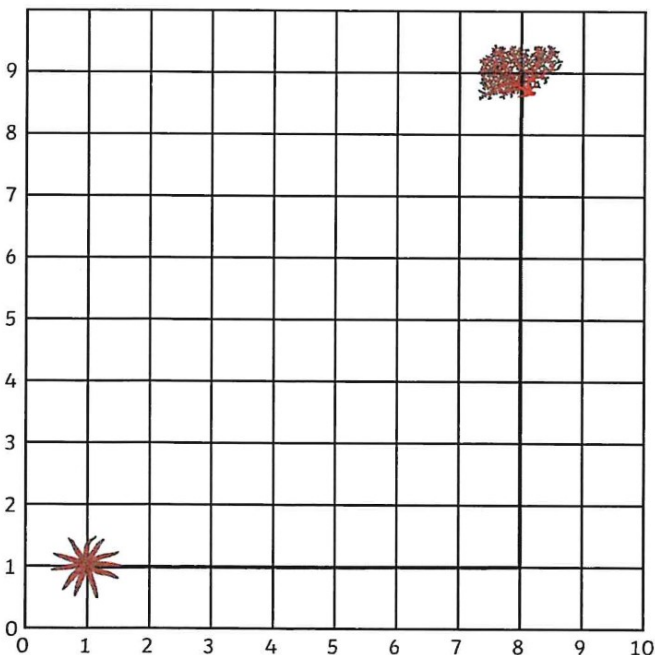
