E.g hot and cold are antonyms.

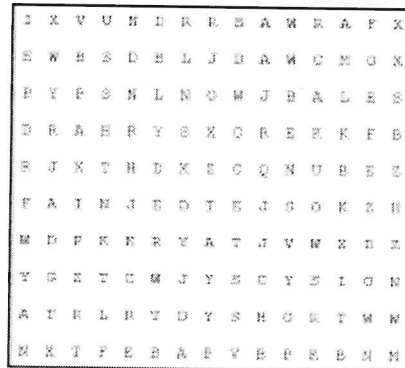
