

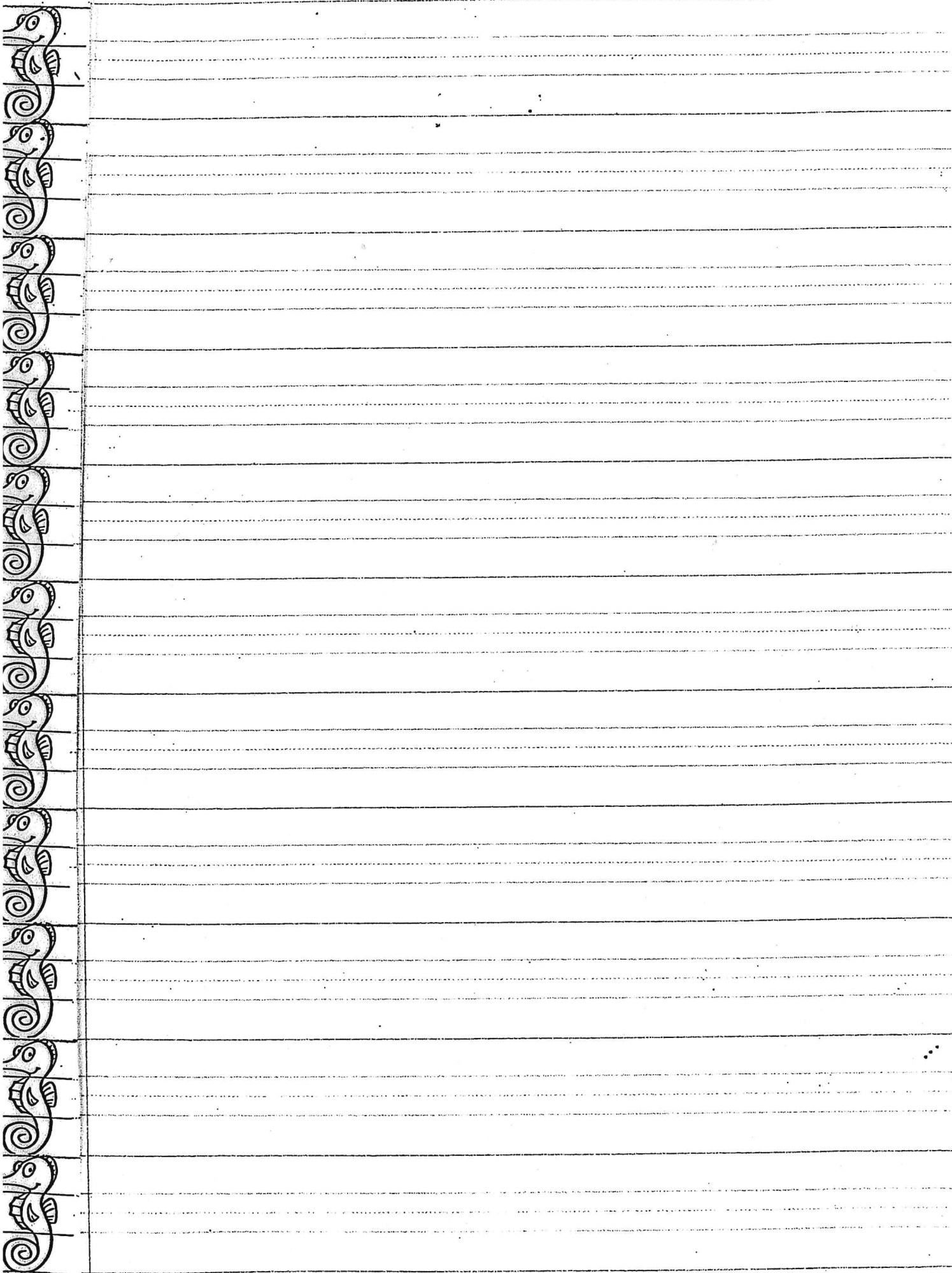

What Does a Dog Look Like?

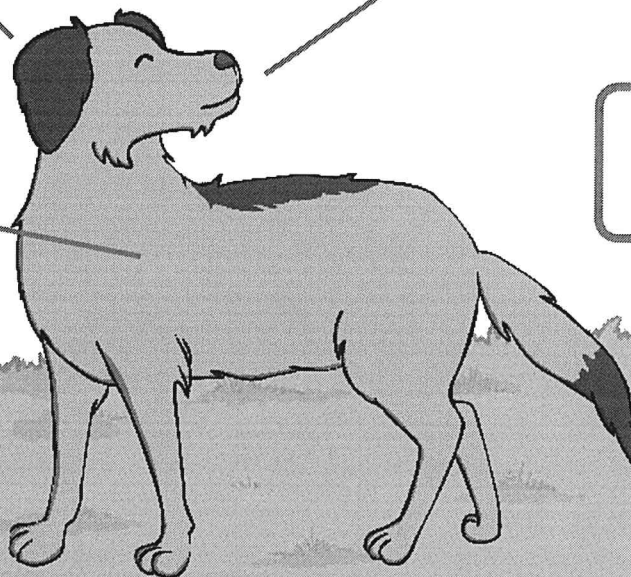
