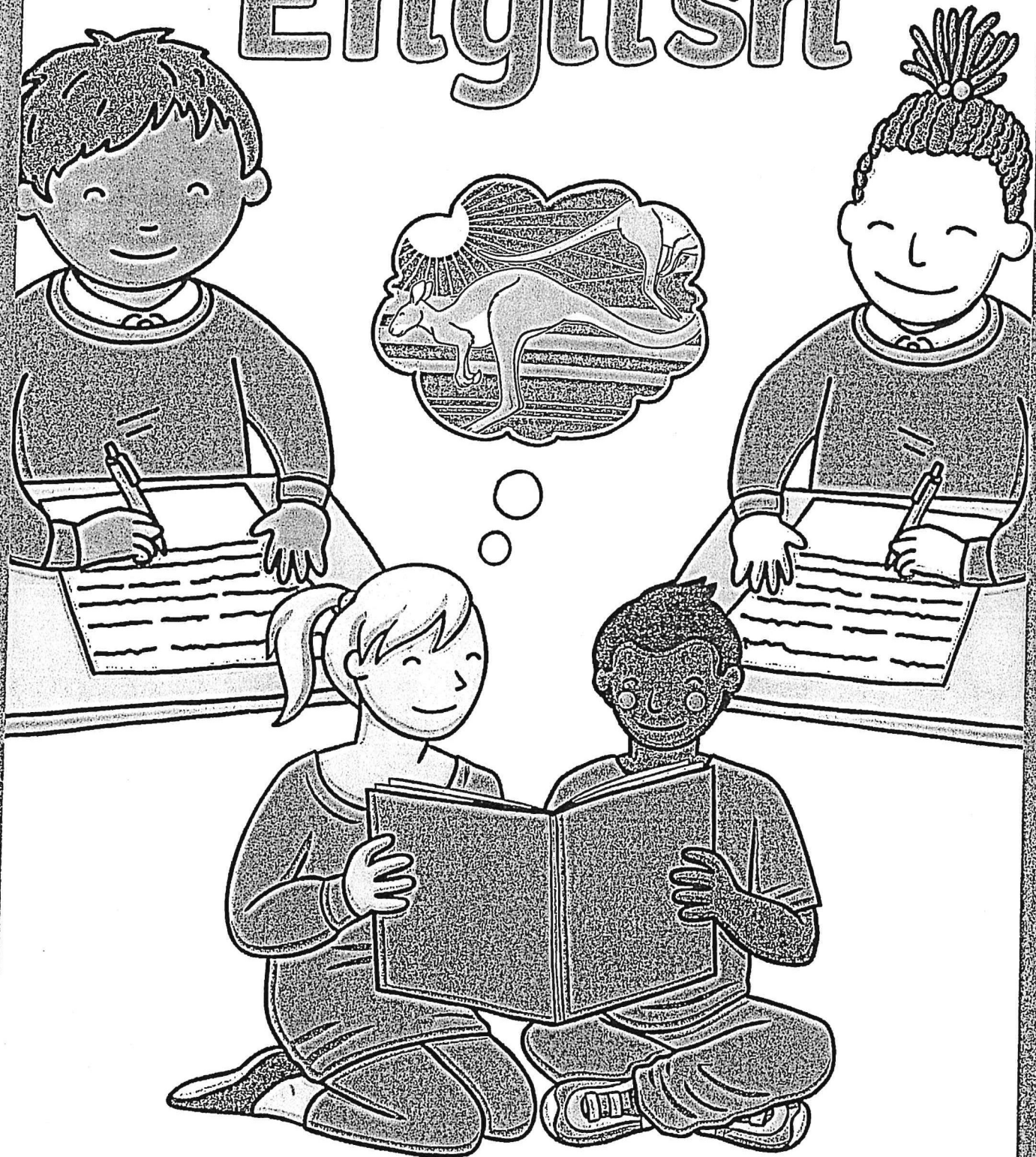

## **Kakadu National Park**

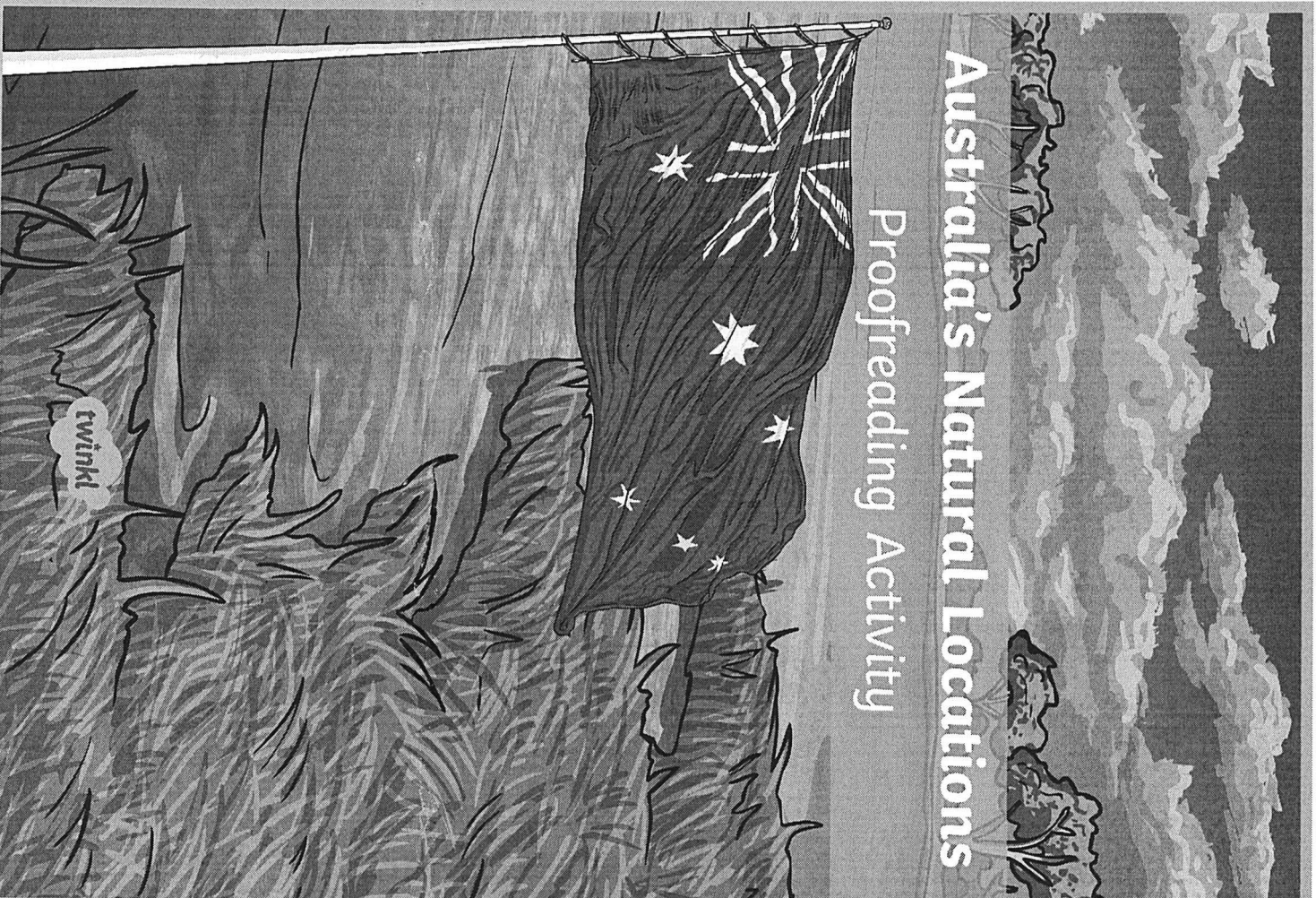
Australia has some of the most diverse land scapes in the world. It's many astounding natural attractions are scattered around the country.

## **The Daintree Rainforest**

They Daintree Rainforest is located on the northeast coast of Queensland. It is the part of the largest continuous area of tropical rain forest on the Australian continent and spans around 1200 squarekilometres.

The Kuki Yalanji people are the Traditional Owners and ongoing Custodians of the daintree Rainforest.

Visitors to the Daintree Rainforest can hike explore, cruise the river and stay in the eco-freindly rainforest accommodation.

## **Flinders Ranges**

The Flingers Ranges are located in south australian, 200km north of Adelaide and strech for 430km.

Wilpena Pound a natural amphi theatre shaped like a largecrater, is the most notable feature off the Flinders Ranges.

The Flinders Ranges are home to the yellowfooted rock wallaby and many flora and Fauna adapted to the semi-arid climate

Visitors can hike, drive for-wheel vehicles and camp in an the Flinders Ranges.



### Ningaloo Reef and Shark Bay

Ningaloo Reef and shark Bay are located on the northwest coastal region of Western Australia both the reef and the bay is World Heritage sites

NingalooReef stretches 260km and is home to diverse marine wild life, including whale sharks and manta rays.

Shark Bay has exceptional naturel features, including diverse seagrass beds and stromatolites (deposits that are sed to be the oldest lifeforms on Earth).

visitors to Ningaloo Reef and Shark Bay can snorkel, dive, sail, watch wildlife an camp.

### The Snowy Mountains

The Snowy Mountains is located in southern NewSouth Wales and are part of the Great Dividing Range

Mount Kosciuszko the highest mountain in Australia is located in the Snowy Mountains.

*'THEIR was movement at the station, for the word had passed around*

*That the colt from old Regret had got away...'*

Visitors too the Snowy Mountains can ski and snow board, hike, mountain bike go horse riding and camp.



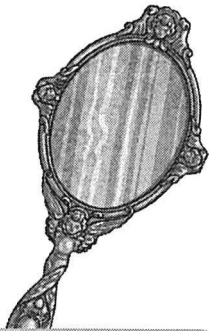

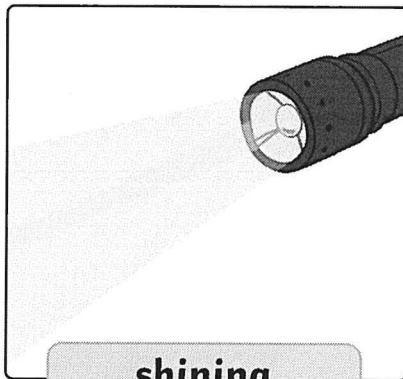

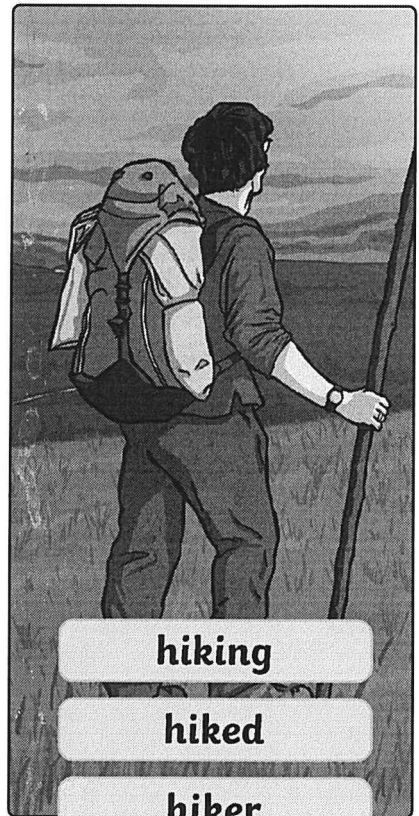
