The <u>introduction</u>: purpose of, what's included, how does the author introduce the topic, what information is important in the introduction

The <u>paragraphs</u>: purpose of, what's included (should have at least 3 paragraphs)

Subheadings: purpose of

<u>Topic sentence</u>: purpose of, what's included (**TEE T**opic sentence, **E**vidence, **E**laboration)

## Concluding statement:

<u>Details</u>: what information does the author include, (important details and ones that are interesting to the reader)

<u>Vocabulary:</u> technical words (subject specific nouns), descriptive verbs, present tense

Additional information: maps, graphs, illustrations,
